- 43rd Annual Dia de los Muertos on November 2, 2020.

All entries will be considered however, we cannot guarantee your acceptance to any exhibit. All applications undergo a selection process to ensure the notifications of acceptance will be delivered on or before the specified dates on the applications.

We request that you return the enclosed applications, photos, sketches, and ideas to Centro Cultural Aztlan no later than Monday, September 14, 2020, to ensure your intent to participate and to be included in all promotional materials. Final decisions will be made once artwork has been delivered. Due to the high volume of entries late submissions will not be accepted. Please refer to the agreements for drop-off deadlines or installation dates.

Centro Aztlan will create a Community Altar in which everyone is invited to bring pictures and mementos to commemorate your loved ones.

This year our intention is to highlight the artists personal experiences through Covid-19, and if you were affected and would like to submit a painting to honor, remember and express it in a creative way, we invite you to submit 1 painting for our Dia de los Muertos exhibition.

There is no restriction on size, and is open to any medium.

Artist Release and Acknowledgement:

I hereby make an application participate as exhibitor with Centro Cultural Aztlan. As an exhibitor I agree to abide by the rules as set forth within this application and other rules that have been or may need to be established by Centro Cultural Aztlan. I understand the decisions of the Centro Cultural Aztlan are final and cannot be appealed. For consideration, the sufficiency of which is acknowledge and stipulated, I hereby release and forever discharge the Centro Cultural Aztlan and its directors, officers, administration agents and employees from any and all claims, demands, suits, cause of action, liability cost, and expenses and damages arising out of or in any way connect with the exhibit. I understand that Centro Cultural Aztlan reserves the right, in sole discretion, to determine and advise exhibitor if any of the exhibitors work does not conform to the rules regulations, or standards established for the exhibit. I agree that such work shall, upon request by the Centro Cultural Aztlan be immediately removed from the exhibit.

I understand that the artist is responsible for delivery and pick up of all artwork for the exhibition. All work must be ready for hanging with appropriate hanging wire and frames or display. The quoted price of the artwork is the true and correct value of each piece.
